• MK1, WK1 (no age categories)

#### PRIZE MONEY :

• The entry fee of each category will be fully distributed to the winners of the categories

# **CLASS 3.8 PRINCIPLES:**

- Only mass-produced (manufactured in large quantities by an automated mechanical process) plastic (rotomolded, thermoformed or blowmolded) boats freely available for purchase on open market are permitted
- K1 Maximum length 3.80 m
- Boats must be filled with airbags
- Other ICF WWC rules are respected (personal equipment)
- ICF to provide boats and spray skirts in a limited amount to rent for free at the starting area of the competition
  - In case an athlete is using equipment provided by ICF, it must be returned immediately after the finish of the race



### **COMPETITION FORMAT INFORMATION:**

#### Start:

- Start ramp located on the bridge above the Olympic course
- Start ramp open all the time, athletes must start by themselves
- Start Order "Ready" steady position, then "Go".
- Starting position: one hand on the platform, paddle in the other hand



#### Scoring:

- Two runs for each athlete, better time to count as individual result
- Fastest time to win the category

#### Schedule:

- Pre-competition briefing to be held at 16.50 at the start area
- First start: 17.00
- Start order to be randomly assigned by ICF
- Start order by category: MK1, WK1, MK1, WK1
- Awarding ceremony: 15 minutes after the last start at the podium area
