TRANSPORT AND ACCESS

By car

Bratislava is situated at the intersection of several important motorways. The distance to Prague is 330 km, Budapest 200 km and Vienna 65 km. If you are bringing your own car, you need to display a valid motorway tax sticker (known as 'dialnicka znamka'), available at borders or petrol stations. The minimum validity period is ten days (costs around EUR 10).

By plane

BRATISLAVA AIRPORT (BTS) Official website: www.bts.aero

There are direct flights to a number of destinations in Europe and a number of airlines operate their direct routes to Bratislava – RYANAIR, Pobeda, flydubai, Cyprus Airways, Smartwings, air cairo, Wizz Air. Bratislava airport can be reached from the city centre in 15–20 minutes. To get to the city center you can take a taxi – do not forget to ask about the price in advance or use HOPIN mobile app. If you travel on the budget, take the bus no. 61 to the main train station. From here, you can walk to the city centre in 15 minutes or take bus no 93 (exit Hodžovo námestie) or tram no 1 (exit Námestie SNP). Bus tickets are available from ticket machines at bus stops or in kiosks. The tickets which cost around EUR 1 must be validated in the buses.

The airport at Vienna -Schwechat is only 40 kilometres west of Bratislava and Slovaks mainly use it for long-haul flights. It is one of the main gateways to Slovakia. Buses to Bratislava depart at 30 to 60-minute intervals. Tickets can be bought on the bus; check the following companies eurolines.sk, regiojet.com, flixbus.com.

By train

Bratislava connects to the main lines from Prague, Budapest, Vienna and various regions in Slovakia. Bratislava has two railway stations – the Main Station and Petržalka. The Main Station is well connected to the rest of the city via trams, buses or trolleybuses and you can get to the Old Town on foot in only 15 minutes. From the train station in Petržalka, the no. 80, 91, 93 buses take you to the city centre.

Thanks to the joint initiative between the Slovak Olympic and Sports Committee and the Olympic Training Center a Quarantine Center for top sports was established in Šamorín with the aim to help Slovak sport by ensuring the continuity of sports training. The statute of the quarantine center for elite sports was supported by the State Secretary of the Ministry of Education, Youth, and Sports of the Slovak Republic. Ivan Husár, as well as the Government Plenipotentiary for Youth and Sport, Karol Kučera. It was approved by the Central Crisis Headquarters while respecting the tightened regime in relation to the fight against the spread of coronavirus COVID-19.

ACCOMODATION

Definitive Covid19 Health and Safety protocol will be published according to actual health situation. Access will be granted only with a negative RT-PCR test for COVID-19 upon arrival to the "WCH Village"

The transfer from **X-BIONICSPHERE** to Divoka voda Venue will we available per boat shuttle (ferry) on the Danube River exclusively for WCH participants (10 minutes ride).

The World Championships Village (WCHV) has a preferable location in an isolated part of Šamorín. The area is completely enclosed and offers the possibility of complete seclusion with 24-hour monitored security access consisting of only one entrance gate with controlled entry.

- Hermetically sealed WCHV area offering controlled entry with a ban on entry by all unauthorized personnel.
- Access granted only with a negative COVID-19 test and subsequent provisions of mandatory testing for COVID-19 enforced at the entrance to the WCHV.
- The establishment of an isolated quarantine pavilion with a separate entrance for the individuals in isolation who are awaiting the results of the RT-PCR examinations in order to be released into the WCHV normal regime.

The 2021 ICF Canoe World Championships will take place on the brand renovated artificial course at Divoka voda Venue at the Danube River for the following events:

Canoe Slalom - Canoe Slalom & Extreme Slalom Canoeing Wildwater – Sprint

Planned reconstruction will result in a completely new water terrain created by the RapidBlock system, nevertheless, with the preservation of the iconic Niagara fall. The renovation project involves removing concrete obstacles in some defined sections and replacing them with the moveable obstacle system RapidBlocs. The work will include trimming the existing obstacles so that they are flat to the channel with perpendicular sides, grading the channel bed with gravel to create a flat surface, and then installing concrete pads with in-situ Unistrut connectors. RapidBlocs can then be installed with 3-dimensional adjustability into these connectors. There will be no old elements left.

- Nominal entries close: 11/09/2021
- Each athlete competing must be entered by name.
- Team personnel must also be submitted for accreditation at this time. These entries will be used to produce the accreditation cards for all teams.



REMINDER

Entries or accreditation requests sent directly to the committee or the event organiser will NOT be accepted.

All nominal entries proposed after the deadline will have to be deal as a late entry and be accepted by the Chairman of ICF Canoe Slalom Committee (Jean-Michel PRONO) or the Chairman of the ICF Wildwater Canoeing Committeee according to the ICF competition rules.

COVID 19 PROTOCOL

- The HOC will provide a safe environment based on a bubble system dedicated to all participants.
- The ICF, the Slovak Canoe Federation (Host NF) and the Host Organising Committee (HOC) are committed to organise this competition with strong COVID-19 countermeasures in the best interest of all athletes and staff.
- As a key principle all accredited persons will have to provide a negative PCR test result to receive their accreditation and enter the bubble. Later on, the ICF and the HOC will develop a testing policy during the period depending of the evolution of the pandemic.
- A detailed COVID-19 protocol will be developed by the ICF, the Host NF, the HOC and the health local authorities based on an ICF template. The first version of this document will be published one month prior to the competition.
