I. APPLICATION PROCESS

The race should be submitted to the ICF calendar via SDP by the 1st September the year prior the competition.

The ICF Canoe Slalom Committee limits each Federation to hosting no more than two world ranking competitions (level 3) in any calendar year.

III. TITLE OF COMPETITION

The title of the competition must be;

“20**XX** ICF Canoe Slalom World Ranking Competition (**insert venue name**)”.

IV. ICF RULES

The HOC must deliver the competition based on the ICF Canoe Slalom Competition Rules. (Version 01/01/2023)

V. OFFICIALS

The Chief Judge and six (6) other Technical Officials must be IJCSL

VI. INFORMATION BULLETINS

A. Invitational bulletin

The HOC will prepare the invitational bulletin at least 6 months prior the competition.

The bulletin must be disseminated to the NFs and sent to sdp@canoeicf.sport to be posted on the ICF competition website.

B. Team leaders meeting agenda

The HOC will prepare the team leader meeting agenda at least 5 days prior the competition.

The team leader meeting agenda must be disseminated to participating NFs and posted on the competition website.

VII. ENTRIES

The HOC must use the ICF online entry system (SDP) for athlete entries.

Entries can only be accepted from ICF member Federations. Entries cannot be accepted directly to the HOC.

VIII. TIMING & SCORING & RESULTS

It is preferred the HOC use the official ICF Canoe Slalom software "CANOE 123" for results management.

If **not** using Canoe 123, the results need to be produced in Comma Separated Values format (csv) as described in Appendix A.A for a Canoe and Kayak event, in Appendix A.B for a Kayak Cross event.

The results files must be sent an electronic copy of the detailed official results must be provided to the ICF in a specified format ("Canoe123 event xml file or other "csv" file") within seven (7) days of the end of the competition and to the ICF ranking calculation service provider (Rule1.13.1)

IX. REPORTING

Following the competition, the Chief Judge must submit a report to the chair of the Canoe Slalom Committee using the template report available at (*link will be updated soon*)
