New ICF relay rules 2013-

international

- 25.7 Relay distance is 200 m. Relay will raced with single boats only and no mixed crews. Events will be K1 Men, K1 Women and C1 Men x 4 laps. No protests are allowed during heats. Start and finish are located at the finish line. A starting system must be used at both start lines. Recommodation is to use 7 lanes. There will be heats and final only. Advancement system is:
 - 2 heats 1st 3 plus next best fastest time
 - 3 heats 1st 2 plus next best fastest time
 - 4 heats 1st 1 plus next 3 best fastest times



Requirements

With automatic start system

- 2 automatic start lines
- 10 starters (5+5) for each line (some will take care of 2)
- manual operating system for each boat lane
- 2 video systems (VR)
- 2 yellow buoys in the middle of start/finish line (lane #5 buoy)
- 2 PA-systems for starters for starters (1+1)

Without automatic start system

- 2 starters (1+1) or more depending on judge skills and conditions (lanes, place, PAs)
- 2 aligners (1+1)
- 2 video systems (VR)
- 2 yellow buoys in the middle of start/finish line (lane #5 buoy)
- 4 PA-systems for starters and aligners (2+2)



Course for relay





Procedure of relay

- Positions of course umpires are behind and stationary on lanes 2, 4, 6, 8 (all the main lanes are controlled by two officials)
- Coordinative course umpire may stay at the Competion Committee
- Each exchange must be video recorded for later reporting (quality mobile phone with HD accuracy is also valid for judging)
- Finishing bow of boat must always pass the line between next competitor and video camera at the exchange
- Bow of next competitor must stay stationary and may not pass the line before the bow of previous competitor of the same team has finished
- Applications for national or international events (non-ICF events):
 - Aligning commands are continuos for next boats if no starting system exists
 - False starts may cause a time penalty or disqualification if no starting system exists
 - Younger age groups may have relays of 3 x 200m with mixed teams including also different categories
