



## **ATHLETES' GUIDE – CANOE SLALOM**

Dear Athlete,

Thank you for accepting our invitation to the first ever multi-discipline ICF Super Cup where 4 disciplines will contest over 3 action-packed days not just for medals and glory but prize money as well.

It is very important to begin by saying that the circumstances are very different at this Super Cup to what you are used to at any other ICF event. There are no team leaders or coaches accompanying and assisting you, it is YOUR RESPONSIBILITY to wake up in time, warm-up in time, know the hours of training and the meal service, catch the shuttle bus, fix your boat, know the competition schedule, reach the start of your race, dress properly etc.

This is the first time for us as well to run such a multi-discipline event and we try to gather all the necessary information on the following pages for you. This guide is accompanied by a general information bulletin which is supposed to assist your arrival/departure/stay in Hangzhou during the Super Cup, while this one is Canoe Slalom-specific. Please respect us by reading both of them, so you don't have to ask questions that are already answered in writing. The trip to Hangzhou is long, so you should easily find the time to read them. Once you know where to look for information, we count on your self-reliance.

## Rules, events

The Super Cup is an ICF competition, our [canoe slalom rules](#) prevail.

Slalom and Kayak Cross events will be run as during ICF competitions (except for the progression and the training)

Short slalom is the shorter version of our Classic slalom. It will be run using 10 to 12 gates with 2 or 4 of them being upstream ones.

Due to the short training period on the course the gates which will be used during the competition course will be set during the official training on Thursday (10<sup>th</sup> of October). A total of 40 gates will be set on the course during the training, both competition course (classic and short format) will be designed with those gates.

For Classic and Short Slalom, the format will be run as follows:

Heats (one run) and Final (one run) with the same gate settings.

The progression from the Heats will be as follows:

*12 first boats to Final, rest out.*

For Kayak Cross, there will be no Time trials. The event will start straight with the Heats.

The brackets will be defined using the current Kayak Cross World Ranking.

There will be an Athletes' Meeting for all participating athletes (see list at the end of this guide). It is very important for all to be present as we are going to discuss all the details of the competition.

### Athletes' Meeting

Time: **08:30, 10 October** (Thursday), 2024

Location: Fuyang Water Sport Center (competition venue)

Provisional start list will be distributed by the 9<sup>th</sup> of October. The entries in each event have to be confirmed during the Athletes' Meeting.

### Communication

A whatsapp group is created for sharing information with you before your travel to China. You can use this QR code to sign up:



Once arriving in China, you'll find that whatsapp is not supported, so it's important to install WeChat on your phone, which is the local equivalent of whatsapp.



### Boats

Boats are going to be transported from the airport to the venue by the organising committee. The plan is to have two transports per day so early arrivals can already train in the afternoon but the ones landing after 10:00AM will only be able to train the following morning. For kayak cross you will use the boats of a local boat manufacturer, see photos:



### Weather

The forecasted weather in Hangzhou is very pleasant. Daytime temperatures in October normally reach 23-25 degrees and rarely go under 15 for the evenings. Light wind and some scattered showers are always a possibility but most days are dry.

### Bibs

At the athlete's meeting you will receive one bib that you will use during all along the week, the same bib for all the different events.

### Medal Ceremonies

During the medal presentations you must wear your national uniforms as during any other ICF Competitions (World Championships and World Cups). We are running an extremely tight schedule with four disciplines competing almost simultaneously. The medal ceremonies are similarly tight-packed so please never be late! We have 4 minutes to run each ceremony, not more. Anthems are not played and flags are not hoisted.
