

## ICF PARACANOE CLASSIFIER TRAINEE WORKSHOP - NOTTINGHAM, UK.

GOAL: 1.) To disseminate awareness and knowledge of the new ICF Paracanoe Classification system

2.) To give more athletes earlier exposure to the classification system in advance of international competitions

3.) To increase the number of trainee classifiers at the national level

WHEN:	July 17-18, 2018
WHERE:	Nottingham, UK
<b>REGISTRATION:</b>	250 €/person fee payable to the ICF by July 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2018
ACCOMMODATION:	Accommodation is at the National Water Sports Centre at a special British Canoeing rate of £39.10 per night for a single room and £47.60 for a twin room. The rooms are basic but pleasant.
TRAVEL:	East Midlands Airport - the closest airport is East Midlands Airport (27km from the National Water Sports Centre) with regular flights to/from Europe.
	London Luton Airport – London Luton Airport has regular trains to Nottingham (travel time 1.5 hours) <u>https://www.london-luton.co.uk/to-and-from-lla</u>
	London Heathrow Airport - London Heathrow Airport trains run into Paddington Station (central London), transfer by tube to London St Pancras and then a train up to Nottingham (total travel time over 2 hours). Alternatively National Express and Megabus run services directly from Heathrow Airport to Nottingham (taking 3.5 hours) <u>https://www.heathrow.com/transport-and- directions</u>
	British Canoeing can provide free transfers to and from Nottingham Station or East Midlands Airport and the National Water Sports Centre.
