

Aus Power plugs: Please ensure you pack the correct power plugs, Aus power is 240V, 3 pin plugs as shown below. You will need adaptors if you do not already have 3pin plugs.



What to bring: Please pack a water bottle and a Keepcup, there will be water stations around the venue where you can refill.

WEATHER

In September/October, Penrith typically experiences daytime temperatures around 25 °C, cooling to around 10 °C overnight.

Rainfall is generally low, with forecasts indicating an average of around five rainy days in October. As part of your event uniform, you will be provided with a hat and a rain jacket.

Please remember the sun is extremely strong in Australia. Ensure that you pack suncream and apply it regularly throughout the day.

Daylight Savings - On Sunday 6 October, daylight saving begins in Australia. The clocks will go forward 1 hour, so you will lose an hour overnight. Please be aware of this for any travel schedules you may have on Sunday.

ARRIVING IN AUSTRALIA

You will be required to complete an Incoming Passenger Card (IPC) on the final leg of your flight to Australia. Please note, one of the required details on the form is your intended place of stay in Australia.

Please remember that all paddling clothing and equipment - including items such as boat sponges, must be completely dry before bringing into Australia. If items are not dry they will be held at the airport, usually for a few days.

Please check and prepare your equipment carefully before travelling.

We have been working closely with Sydney International Airport to make boat collection and drop off as smooth as possible.

For boat collection at the airport (and drop off on your way home), please follow these directions.

 Follow the signs to arrivals and stay in the middle lane (on Arrival Court) labelled 'Parking/Valet/Pick up'



2. Staying on Arrival Court, follow the road around past the Car park building on your right and the taxi rank on your left. Take a left turn here.



3. You will then arrive at the designated door where your boats will be delivered from the aiport here.
