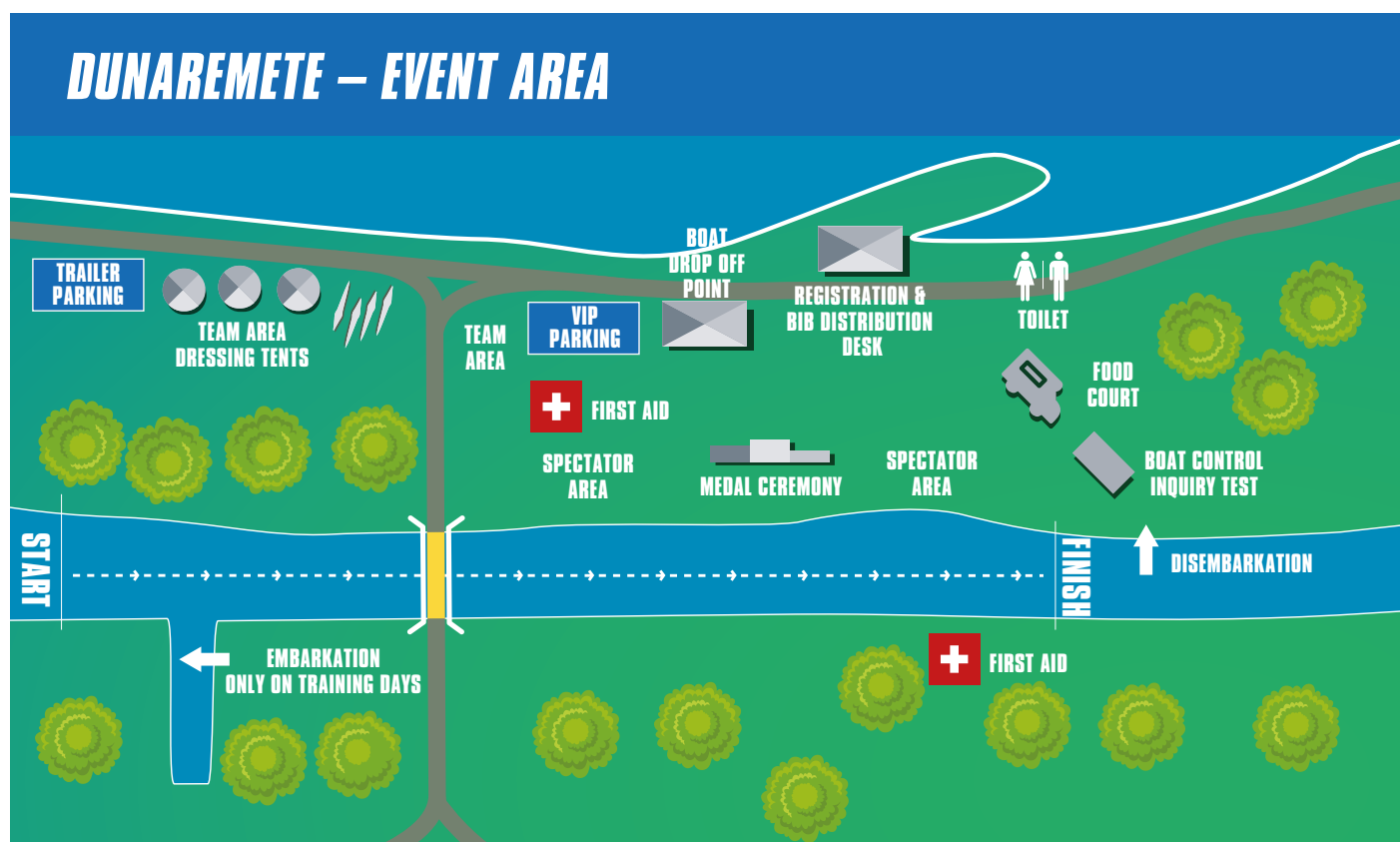

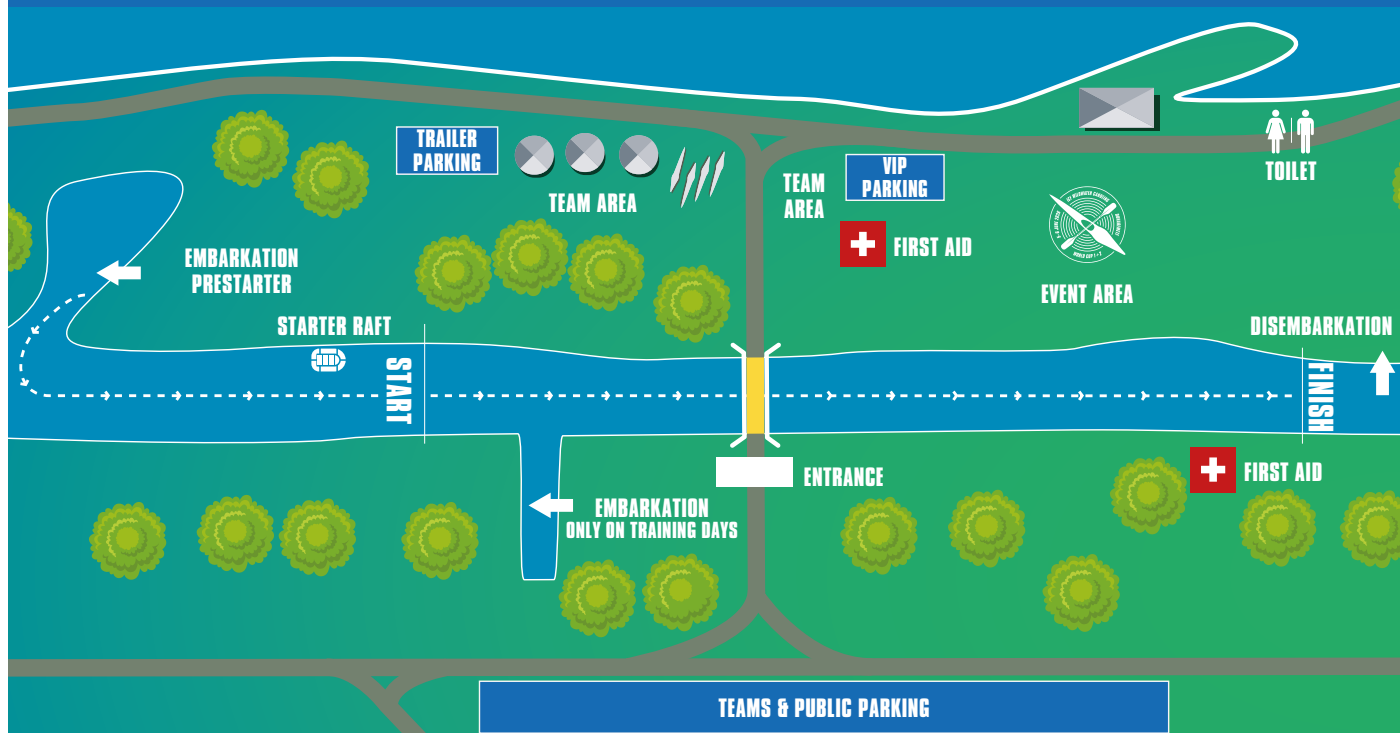

# REGISTRATION & BIB SINGLET

## OPENING HOURS

June 3, Wednesday: 13:00–17:00

June 4, Thursday: 09:00–12:00, 13:00–17:00

June 5, Friday: 07:00–11:00, 15:00–18:00

June 6, Saturday: 08:00–11:00, 13:00–17:30

The Registration and BIB Singlet Desk will be in the only building at the competition venue. The building will be clearly marked with a **REGISTRATION** sign.

Team Leaders, as well as representatives of Masters and U14 athletes, are kindly requested to come directly to the Registration and BIB Singlet Desk upon arrival.

To minimise the number of on-site payments, we kindly ask all teams and participants to settle the amounts indicated in their Participation Fee Summaries in advance, if they have not already done so.

Acceptable methods of payment: cash (EUR), credit card (Visa, Eurocard / Mastercard)





Following the Team Leaders Meeting, each competitor will receive their own individual BIB singlet at the Registration and BIB Singlet Desk, which will serve as their identification during the event(s). It is the responsibility of each competitor to wear the singlet.

Please note that a deposit is required for the BIB. The deposit must be paid on site at the Registration and BIB Singlet Desk in cash only.

**The deposit cannot be paid on site by credit card.**

### **DEPOSIT PAID ON SITE – CASH ONLY 50 EUR / National Federation**

**For Masters and U14 athletes, either a photo ID document may be deposited as a guarantee, or a 50 EUR cash deposit must be paid.**

The deposit is 100% refundable. The BIB must be picked up together with the registration, and athletes may return the BIB during opening hours to the Registration and BIB Singlet Desk once they have no more races. The deposit will be refunded in cash on site.

If the BIB is lost, the HOC will replace it for another deposit.





# MEALS & WATER

## LUNCH / EARLY DINNER

Please note that the participation fee does not include meals; therefore, all participants are kindly requested to arrange their meals individually.

To support athletes and team members during the event period, the following meal options will be available:

The food truck will offer a variety of breakfast items (such as toasts and egg-based dishes), as well as lunch and dinner options including pizzas, flatbreads, burritos, fajitas, salads, and desserts.

Both the restaurant and the food truck will be prepared to meet the needs of athletes and teams throughout the event period.

Payment will be possible in cash (EUR) and by credit/debit card.

## **DRINKING WATER**

Bottled drinking water can be collected at the Registration Desk between 2 and 6 June, from 08:00 to 11:00 each day.

On 1 June, bottled water can be collected between 14:00 and 17:00.

Selective bottle collection bins will also be placed throughout the venue area. We kindly ask all participants to use these bins for empty bottles in order to support environmentally friendly waste management. Let's be mindful of our environment!





# BOAT STORAGE AND PARKING

## DUNAREMETE – EVENT AREA & SPRINT RACE

Boat racks will be provided in the Team Area, as indicated on the venue map. Teams are kindly requested to store their boats in this designated area.

Vehicle access to the Team Area will be permitted only temporarily, for the purpose of unloading boats at the designated Boat Drop-Off Point, and for loading boats after training sessions or races.

Between these periods, vehicles must be parked in the designated Team & Public Parking area. Trailers may remain inside the venue, in the designated Trailer Parking area next to the Team Area, as indicated on the venue map.

We kindly ask all teams to follow this arrangement to avoid blocking each other, to keep traffic routes clear, and to ensure a safe and well-organised venue for all participants.





## KISBODAK – CLASSIC

At the Classic race start area in Kisbodak, vehicle access will also be permitted only temporarily for boat drop-off and loading purposes.

A maximum 5-minute drop-off will be allowed at the designated Boat Drop-Off Point near the roundabout. Teams are kindly requested to unload their boats as quickly as possible and then move their vehicles and trailers to the designated parking area.

Please follow the signs on site and the instructions of the organisers when entering or parking at either location.



# SAFETY REGULATIONS ON WATER & MEDICAL CARE

The Host Organising Committee will provide professional kayak-based water rescue service during the official training sessions and on race days.

From **30 May to 2 June**, water rescue service will be provided during the official training hours with 3 professional kayak-based rescuers, while from 3 to 6 June, the service will be provided with 6 professional kayak-based rescuers, who will be on standby at the Drop points indicated on the course maps.

Please note that water rescue service is provided during the official training and competition periods only. The Host Organising Committee cannot take responsibility for any accidents occurring outside the supervised periods or outside the designated competition and training areas.

In addition, on competition days, medical services will be provided by the National Ambulance Service with first aid and doctor on duty. The costs of hospital and clinic assistance services are to be covered by your medical insurance policy, the Organisers are not responsible for covering your expenses in connection with hospital treatment, dental treatment or any other medical treatment.



# TEAM LEADERS' MEETING & COMMUNICATION



The Team Leaders' meeting will take place on Thursday, June 4 at 17:00. All Team Leaders are invited to join the 2026 Wildwater Worldcups HUN/SVK/ITA WhatsApp group by scanning the QR code or click on this [link](#). The Competition Committee and the HOC will share all essential information to the teams through this group.

## MEDAL AWARDING CEREMONIES

Victory ceremonies will be organised in two separate 30-minute blocks according to the official competition schedule. All athletes concerned (wearing their national outfit) are requested to be present at the Medal Ceremony area at least 10 minutes prior to the start of the relevant ceremony block.

Victory ceremonies will start exactly at their officially scheduled time. In case an athlete arrives late to the meeting point, the ceremony will proceed without him/her.

Please note that caps, sunglasses, and flags are not permitted on the podium.
