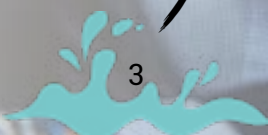

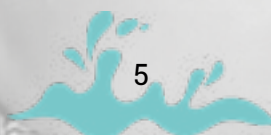

LOCATION

El Astillero, located at the foot of Peña Cabarga, is just 7.5 km from Santander, the regional capital.

The municipality is geographically defined by the estuaries that surround it: Ría de Solía, Ría de Boo, and Ría de Astillero (part of the Bay of Santander). It borders the municipalities of Camargo, Villaescusa, Piélagos, Medio Cudeyo, and Marina de Cudeyo.

The convergence of these estuaries and the bay's coastline creates vast wetlands (Marismas Blancas and Marismas Negras), which serve as a nesting site for various migratory birds throughout the year.

The boarding area and the Festival facilities will be located south of the Pontejos Bridge:

COMPETITION COURSE

The competition will follow the ICF Paracanoe Competition Rules:

- Long Circuit
- Short Circuit
- Half-lap of the short circuit

The starting line will be south of the Pontejos Bridge, and the finish line will be in front of the rowing club.

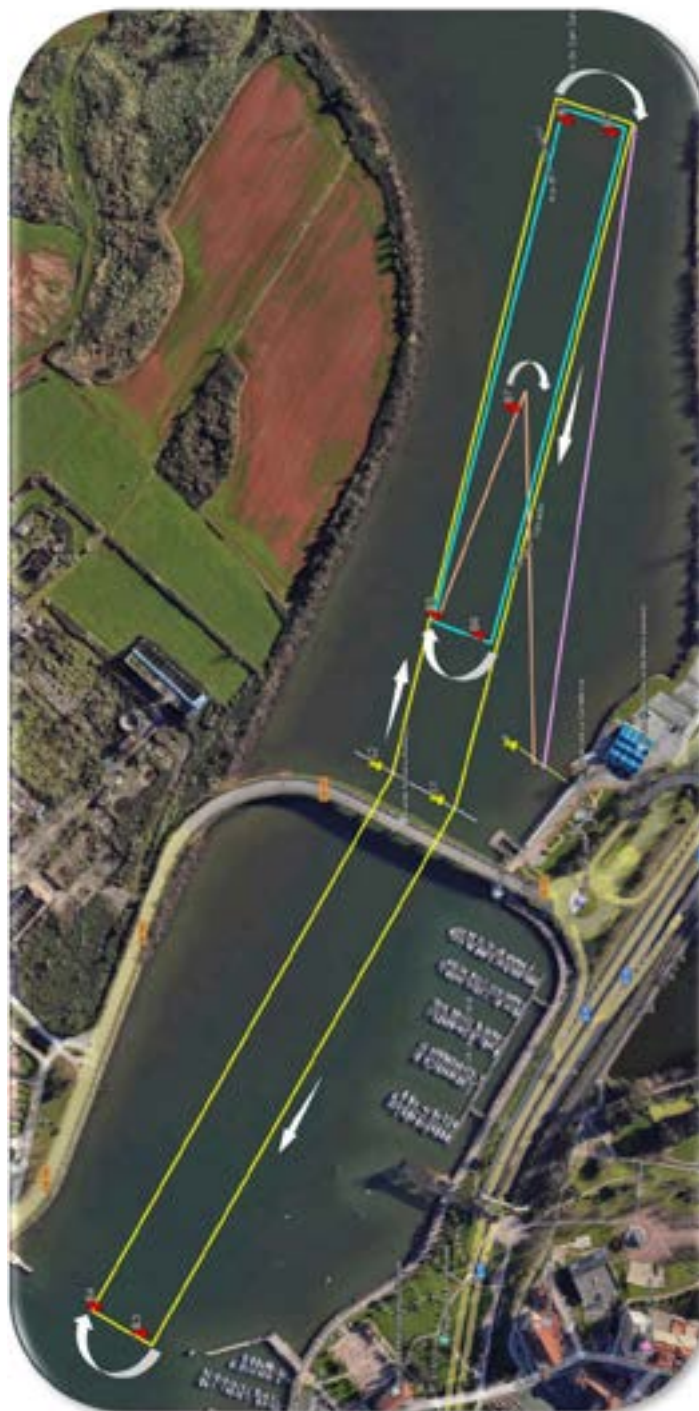
The competition committee may modify the course if weather or water conditions require it. Any changes will be communicated and confirmed at the team leaders' meeting.

DESCRIPTIONS

- Starting line: marked by buoys S1-S2.
- Long circuit: B1-B2-B3-B4 (in yellow).
- Short circuit: B1-B2-B5-B6 (in pale blue).
- Half a lap of the short circuit: B5-B7-F (in pale orange).
- To finish from the last lap: B6-F (in pink).
- The start will be taken towards B1-B2.
- All turns will be taken from left to right, keeping the buoys to starboard.
- To reach the finish line, competitors must pass between F and the shore.

PARCOURS AND DISTANCES

- KL1/VL1 (Men/Women): 6,8 km = 2 x long circuit, 2 x short circuit and half a lap of the short circuit.
- KL2/KL3/VL2/VL3 (Men/Women): 10,2 km = 4 x long circuit, 2 short circuit (from the second to finish).



ENTRIES

Eligible Participants:

Clubs and athletes holding a valid national license.

Independent entries from individuals are not accepted.

Clubs must register their athletes via website before Friday, 27th June at

www.festivalnauticoinclusivo.com

Required Information. For each registered athlete, the following details must be provided:

- Full name
- Date of birth
- ID number
- Paracanoe sport class
- Certification from the national federation confirming:
 - » The athlete holds a valid sports license
 - » The sport class assigned by the National or International Classification Panel
- For Open exhibition class athletes, a certificate from the national federation confirming:
 - » The athlete has an eligible impairment for IPC but not for ICF, allowing them to compete in the event.
