Basic COVID-19 Countermeasures

- Wear a face mask at all times
- Wash your hands regularly and use hand sanitiser where available
- Keep two metres' distance from athletes and at least one metre from others, including in operational spaces
- Avoid physical contact, such as hugging, high-fives, handshakes, etc
- Disinfect your hands when entering each area and room
- Do not share towels, drinks bottles or other equipment
- Disinfect your hands before and after using equipment
- Keep your stay at the venue as short as possible

Introduction

The Playbook contains the principles of COVID-19 countermeasures.

These guidelines describes the details of the sport specific COVID-19 countermeasures for the Canoe Slalom competition.

These guidelines are designed to create a safe competition environment for all Games participants.

TOKYO2020 has developed these guidelines with reference to the basic proposal of the "2021 ICF CSL & WWC COVID19 PROTOCOL" published by the ICF.


Facilities and Operation

1. Sports-Specific Area

- In addition to the Playbook, The Kasai canoe slalom centre will operate safely and securely in accordance with the following guidelines.
- Hand sanitiser will be available at all entry points and within each room. Anyone entering or leaving a tent or room must use hand sanitiser.
- Athletes or team officials who have finished their duty, should leave the competition venue wherever possible.
- Avoid the 3Cs (Crowded Places, Close-contact settings, Confined and enclosed spaces).
- A CO2 monitor will be installed in each room to encourage ventilation. Regular ventilation is required.
- In order to create a safe competition environment for all competitors, a patrol officer will be assigned on the FOP.


2. 1st Athlete lounge (including meals)

- The number of seats in the 1st Athletes' Lounge is limited, so please respect each others' access.
- Each table will be equipped with separation screens
- Each table will be equipped with a disinfectant spray and paper towels so that athletes can disinfect it before and after use.
- The catering will consist of a one-way system.
- All rubbish must be disposed of after the meal in the designated area (signed).
- Masks must be worn at all times, except when eating and drinking.
- 2nd Athletes' lounge is available for use.
- Athletes eat their lunch in the 1st lounge and are not allowed to take lunch to 2nd lounge.



3. 2nd Athletes' Lounge (no meals provided)

- This will provide a place for athletes to rest in addition to the 1st Athletes' Lounge.
- Each NF will always use the same place.
- Each table will be equipped with separation screens.
- Each table will be equipped with a disinfectant spray and paper towels so that the athletes can disinfect the tables before and after use.
- Masks must be worn at all times, including when talking.



4. Changing room and toilet

- Follow the foot stickers and keep a social distance while waiting in line.
- Handwashing is essential and hand soap is always available
- Make sure to put the used towels in the collection box (changing room).
- Do not talk when using the changing room and toilet.
- Changing room and toilet facilities for teams will be cleaned on a two hourly basis.

5. Team tent

- All members should be discouraged from intermingling in the team tent.
- Team members must wear a mask at all times, even in the team tent.
- Team members must not visit other team tents.
- Hand sanitiser will be made available for each team tent but team members MUST also provide their own hand sanitiser and disinfectant wipes.
- Teams are responsible for disinfecting their own desks and chairs during their stay.(TOKYO2020 will clean and disinfect in the morning or evening when Athletes are not at the venue.)
- CO2 monitor will be set up for each tent and ventilation will be provided through the entrances and exits as appropriate.


6. Boat Rack

- Boats must be stored in the storage area allocated to each athlete and not be touched by other people's equipment.
- All equipment, including the boat, is the responsibility of the athlete and the team.
- Any items such as boat or paddle, that is handled by more than one person, will require disinfection by the participating personnel.

7. Sport Information

- Reduce the number of printed handouts for each NOC (only the start list will be given on paper) and distribution will be electronic.
- All technical information will be available electronically and published by Sport information.
- Conversations with team officials and TOCOG staff should be limited at the minimum. Official training and Competition Bib numbers will be distributed in a closed bag.
- Bibs will be self-managed during the period.

8. Boat repair Area

- Conversations with athletes and staff should be limited to a minimum even when wearing a mask and loud voices should be avoided.
- The sides of the repair tent should always open in two directions.

9. Athlete Dry Area

- Masks must be worn and conversation between athletes is prohibited.
- Keep stay to a minimum.

10. Ice Bath Area

- It is recommended to use the ice bath inside the team tent.
- Teams must not share ice baths
- It is the responsibility of the NF to manage and use it.

11. Ergometer Area

- Disinfect hands before use. / wipe with alcohol wipe after each use by user.
- Yoga mats and other equipment should not be shared. Users should be provided with individual equipment.
- Use is limited to 30 minutes.
- Limit the number of people who can use the area. Maximum 8 people.
- CO2 monitor will be set up and ventilation will be provided through the entrances and exits as appropriate by users.
- Ergometer room will be disinfected three times a day.

12. Pontoons (e.g. embarkment, start, disembarkment)

- Only athletes will have access to the pontoon or boarding area.
- Only one boat will be allowed access to the pontoon at a time.
- Pontoons will be disinfected at regular intervals.
- It is mandatory that athletes wear a mask until the embarkation pontoon and keep their mask with them (in a dry pocket) so that it can be worn at disembarkation.

13. Start pool, Lake and Warm-up course

- It is recommended to limit the interaction between athletes from different NOCs on the water.
- No sharing of drink bottles. Athletes and team officials must dispose of their own drink bottles in the bin. Do not leave personal drink bottles at the pontoon or start area
- Athletes and coaches should avoid talking loudly.

14. Bridge

- Do not stop at bridges, pass directly over them.

15. Bank of FOP

- There will be stickers along the course 1.5 m apart to indicate appropriate physical distance between accredited people.
- Patrol officers will encourage people to keep a physical distance.
- No loud cheering or running is allowed.
- Do not stop to cheer on the right bank. It is recommended that athletes only use the right bank for observation of the course.

16. Finish, Athlete Celebration Area

- It is mandatory that athletes wear a mask until the embarkation pontoon and keep their mask with them (in a dry pocket) so that it can be worn at disembarkation.
- TOP 3 athletes (Outstanding-issue) waiting in the Celebration Tent will remove their masks only during interviews.
- There will be no handshakes or embraces.

17. Equipment control

- There will be a one-way system for boat measurement.
- The technical officials and sport volunteers must wear a mask and check the boats and equipment without physical contact or by using gloves or sanitising gel before and after the check.
- All post competition boat and equipment control will be organised without athlete / ITOs interaction. If needed, the athlete will be called, and athletes will be requested to wear a face mask.
- Unofficial equipment control will be organised with minimal staff to ensure safety measures:
 - a. Athletes must use hand sanitiser before and after touching any device.
 - b. The staff will disinfect devices after each athlete.

18. Monitor tent, Results Posting tent

- Access is restricted to the team leader only.

19. Enquiry desk

- Restrict access to the IF area.
- The time spent at the enquiry desk should be kept to a minimum.
- If more than one NOC is at the enquiry desk, they may be asked to wait outside after submitting an enquiry.
