

## LA28 Paralympic Games – Paracanoe Qualification Ranking principles

### Principles of the 2028 Paralympic Qualification Ranking system(PQR):

- The Ranking Period runs from 1 May 2026 to 31 May 2028.
- The Paralympic Qualification Ranking System is based upon individual athlete performances in the 200m event of the respective categories (MKL1, WKL1, MKL2, WKL2, MKL3, WKL3, MVL2, WVL2, MVL3, WVL3). Each event category has its own distinct ranking. Ten (10) quota slots are available in each category. The host country directly qualifies one (1) eligible male athlete in Kayak, one (1) eligible female athlete in Kayak, one (1) eligible male athlete in Va'a and one (1) eligible female athlete in Va'a, subject to being registered in the Paralympic Qualification Ranking system. These host country quotas will be deducted from the PQR quota allocation.
- Points achieved at competitions are awarded with the following multipliers:
  - o 2026, 2027 and 2028 World Championships - 1,5x multiplier
  - o 2026, 2027 World Cups - 1x multiplier
  - o 2026, 2027, 2028 Continental Championships - 1x multiplier (Results from only two (2) Continental Championships may be included in the 2028 Paralympic Qualification Ranking for each athlete. At the beginning of the Ranking Period, Continents must designate which two Continental Championships, to be included in the World Ranking Model for Paralympic Qualification.)
  - o National Championships – 0.25x multiplier (Results from only one (1) National Championship per year may be included in the 2028 Paralympic Qualification Ranking for each athlete) The competition standards must be accepted by the ICF.
- The list of competitions is outlined in the Qualification Timeline below.
- In the Event Rankings, up to five (5) best results (highest points) of each individual competitor are counted for each individual's PQR.
- If there is more than one athlete entered in the same event from the same NF at the same competition, both athletes may earn points.
- To be included in the Paralympic Qualification Ranking, the athletes' results must be from more than one continent. If an athlete who has five results does not have results from more than one continent, the athlete's total points will be reduced to four (4) with the lowest rank of the five being removed from consideration. Athletes with less than five (5) results will not be penalized.
- At the end of the Qualification Period, if two (2) or more individual competitors have equal points for the tenth qualification slot in the PQR, the following tie-breaker rules will apply:
  1. The individual athlete with the better result at the 2028 Canoe Sprint & Para Canoe World Championships will rank higher.

- If a tie still exists, then:
  2. The individual athlete with the better result at the 2027 Canoe Sprint & Para Canoe World Championships will rank higher.
