

On or before July 28th registration fees will be \$100 for Junior, U23 and Senior athletes and \$50 for cadets (U14).

After July 28th all emergency entries will incur a \$100.00 fee. Please contact James Cartwright onsite to process emergency registration. No entries will be accepted after August 6th.

Your cooperation is appreciated, as it is necessary to develop training slots, start lists and prepare the schedule for the event in advance. Faxed, mailed, or emailed entries will not be accepted.

EQUIPMENT & BOAT CONTROL

All Junior, U23 and Senior equipment must comply with the <u>ICF Canoe Slalom Rules</u>. Boat weighing will be available in the morning on Thursday, August 7 and will be ready for 30 minutes before the start of racing on each competition day.

ANTI DOPING INFORMATION

Athletes registered and competing at the 2025 National Team Trials are subject to the Canadian Anti-doping Control Program. Anti-doping controls may be conducted on a random basis in accordance with the Canoe Kayak Canada's Anti-Doping Policy and Doping Control Program. http://canoekayak.ca/anti-doping/

Junior, U23 and Senior athletes planning on competing on behalf of CKC at International Competitions will be expected to complete Anti-Doping education through CCES's True Sport Clean education module. <u>True Sport Clean Anti-Doping Education Module</u>. International Athletes must complete the WADA Anti-doping Education Program.

In the 14-day period prior to this competition, athletes and coaches are advised to seek medical counsel prior to utilizing **any** medications, ointments, drops, nutritional supplements, etc. which may be used for acute or chronic medical conditions. Such advice should be provided by physicians familiar with the International Olympic Committee's "banned list of drugs" which can be found on the Canadian Centre for Ethics in Sport's Drug Classification. http://cces.ca/banned-substances-and-methods
