Olympic Solidarity Canoe Sprint Level 1 Course in Albania

Foreword

Regarding the interest canoeing by of the Albanian NOC the ICF and ECA started corresponding o this matter followed by a personal visit by ECA President and Secretary General. As the result the Albanian NOC established the National Canoe Federation in 2017. Not much later they applied for the O.S. financial support for hosting a Technical Corse in Albania. The O.S. approved the support in 2018 but since there was not any model of racing kayak, we agreed to organize the coaches' course when they have appropriate equipment. The ICF/ECA, agreed to donate 6 racing kayaks and 10 kayak paddles to Albania using resources by the development program. This process takes a long time to find a better option to send the material. Unfortunately, the provider has some unexpected issues to solve during the delivery of the equipment. The boats arrive in Tirana, Albania on the second day of the course, nevertheless we still used the equipment during the rest of the course and didn't impact the program.

Dates of course: 18 - 23 November 2019 (6 days)

Location: Tirana Physical Education University for the theory and at the swimming pool for the practical.

Participantion: 20 - 22 people attended the course. Most of them have a sport background in various sports and several have been working as instructors for different sporting activities, like tour kayaking, SUP, other water related activities, and climbing.



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Participants came from four different cities.

Course Programme:

The programme had two phases, theory and practical sessions lasting 6 - 7 hours per day.

The water and weather condition was not suitable for beginner paddlers due to safety reasons, therefore we did the practical on an open swimming pool. It was more suitable regarding the logistics, technical and safety aspects. This venue gave more confidence for the attendees and provided easier progress to the audience involved on the course. At the end of the practical sessions, several people were able to sit in the kayak and paddle experimenting with technical knowledge they learnt. They could recognise better techniques to practice whilst kayaking.

Examination: 17 attendees (15 men and 2 women) took part in the examination and 11 passed.






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NOC and **NF** participation:

The Sec. Gen. of the NOC Albania opened and closed the course. The NOC TD organised the course, attended all the sessions, including practical. The NF' Vice-president also took part in the full course. The NF President Mr. Sokol Topciu closed the course with the Sec. Gen.

The future:

It seems that some participants and the federation are very keen to developing Canoe Sprint in Albania. It was decided to split the six boats for two places where they can start train in the new kayaks.

We visited two potential places for canoe training and competitions in Tirana. One is an artificial lake in the middle of the city, where a lot of people are jogging and cycling. We had in a meeting with the municipality to establish a place to install a canoeing base with the boats with could be used for public as well at the weekend, and this idea seems promising.



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The other place is a beautiful area with a nice lake but not very close to residential areas. It wasn't a good place for daily training just for training camps or competitions.

The development of canoeing in Albania requires further attention and support with equipment by ECA and ICF, and support to incentivise the equality of gender in the athletes and technical staff.
