Pre-Games Training

Goals



 Pre-Games training periods offer an equal and fair access to the Canoe Slalom venue to all National Olympic Committees.

Numbers of days



- ICF basic requirements is **60 days** distributed during the 12 months prior the Olympic Games period.
- This number of days can be subject to discussion between ICF and OCOG depending of the conditions and possibilities of access offered by the Venue Operator the years prior the Olympic Games.
- The final number of days and the calendar is defined at least two years prior the Olympic Games.

Spreading



- The spreading of the 60 days is organised based on :
 - Test Events date
 - ICF discipline calendar
 - Date of the last Olympic Qualification competition.
 - OCOG constraint to prepare the venue

Organisation of training session (1)



 One hour session twice a day during each training days per NOC's.

Each training session should provide for between
25 – 30 boats on the water at a time depending on the capacity of the venue

Organisation of training session – example



• Water on – 7.15

- Morning session
 - Group 1 8.00 to 9.00
 - Group 2 9.00 to 10.00
 - Group 3 10.00 to 11.00
 - Group 4 11.00 to 12.00
- Break

- Afternoon session
 - Group 1 14.00 to 15.00
 - Group 2 15.00 to 16.00
 - Group 3 16.00 to 17.00
 - Group 4 17.00 to 18.00

• Water off – 18.30

Price



 The price is defined by the OCOG at least 3 years prior the Olympic Games after approval by the ICF.

- Previous Games:
 - London 2012: 20 Livres 30 Euros / hour / athletes
 - Rio 2016: 30 Euros / hour / athletes
 - Tokyo 2020: 3600 yen = 30 Euros / hour /athletes

Services to be offered by the OCOG



- Booking system
- Competition course set with at least 50 training gates
- Boat storage during the training period
- Changing rooms (men & women) with toilettes / shower.
- Water rescue service (not mandatory)
- Optional service (at NF/NOC's cost on basis of an agreed fee):
 - Boat storage between pre-games training periods
 - Boat transportation from and to the airports

Remark



 The inclusion of Extreme Canoe Slalom may slightly impact the pre-games training in term od daily operation and spreading.
