## **Waterflow situation**

Following several questions from National Federations the ICF wants, after discussion with the HOC, to give the same information to all participants.

Since 15 September the training conditions are stabilized with 3 pumps with 9,6 m<sup>3</sup> per second.

During the 2016 Olympics Games, the competitions were held with 4 pumps with 12,0 m<sup>3</sup> per second.

The HOC informed yesterday the ICF that the fourth pump is still under maintenance. So at this stage we have no spare pump in case of failure of one of the three operated pumps.

The ICF and the HOC wait for the 4<sup>th</sup> pump to be available and the global assessment of the pumping system to decide if we remain at the training period waterflow until the end or if we can increase it without a major risk for the delivery of the whole World Championship.

The HOC apologizes for the situation and will do his best to assess the situation quickly.
