Accreditations will not be issued until the certificates are marked off.

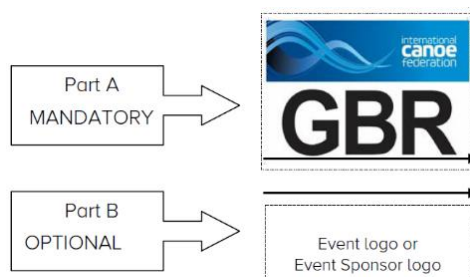

— WHAT A SURPRISE —

Athletes ARE REQUIRED to add an Event sponsor sticker (SLOVAKIA WHAT A SURPRISE) to their boat. This also applies to Kayak Cross boats where possible.

Remark: Kayak Cross boats will be required to have the Nation Sticker placed freely in a suitable place in front of the cockpit. The actual location may vary depending on the model of the boat. The Nation sticker is the same dimensions as for the Canoe Slalom boats.

14. Course approval

- Course approval will take place as per the schedule.
- The ICF wants to remind you that the course designers are:
 - Selected from a pool of people skilled enough and proposed by the NF and
 - Are ITOs, which means independent from any NF during the competition.

Any pressure or harassment towards the course designers, as for any ITOs, may lead to sanctions (see chapter 17. Harassment policies)

National federations feedback about the course designs can be reported to the ICF Technical manager: Thomas Rosset to be integrated into the Course Approval process. Feedback will be accepted from only one representant per federation at the following times:

- Team events course; on Monday from 17:30 to 17:40 at the middle bridge river right
- Heats course; on Thursday from 18:30 to 18:40 at the middle bridge river right
- Semi/Final; on Friday from 18:15 to 18:25 at the middle bridge river right

15. Canoe Slalom events – race information

A. Course design timetable

- The Team events course map and Kayak Cross course map will be distributed on Monday 01st of July at 15:00.
- The Canoe and Kayak Heats and Semifinal/Final course maps will be distributed on Tuesday 2nd of July at 16:30.

B. Team Events – Rules reminder

11.1.2 - In team events, one (1) enquiry per team will be allowed.

11.1.3 - A National Federation may enquire on another National Federation one (1) time during the entire competition

C. Bibs distribution

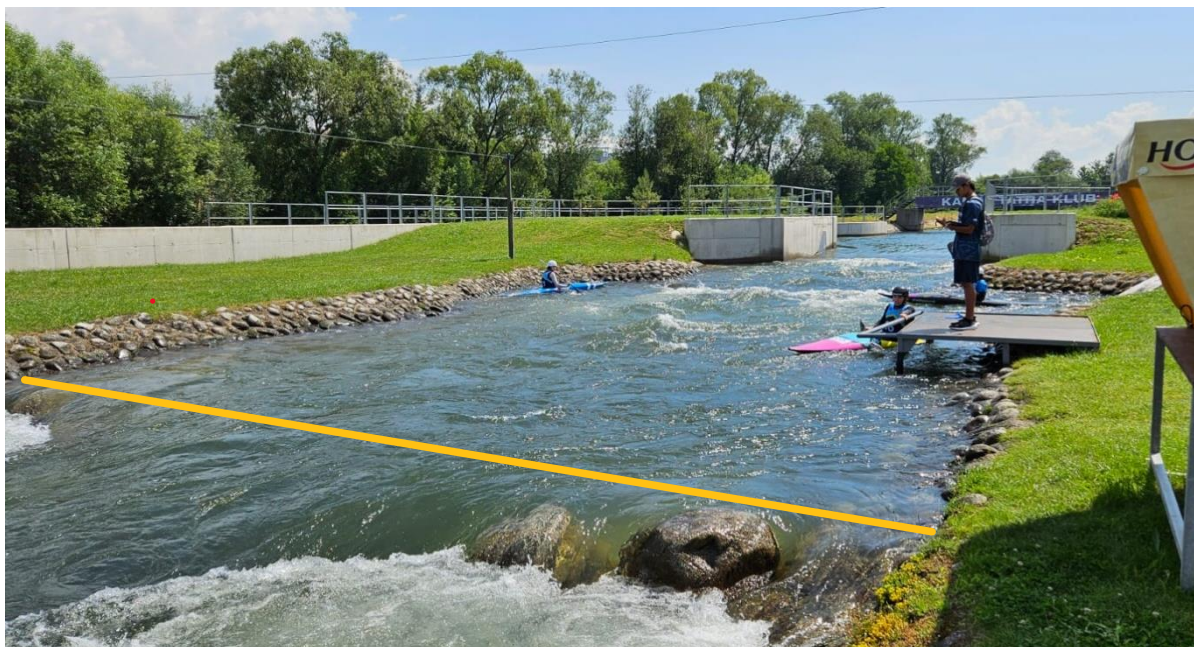
- CSL Competition bibs and Kayak Cross Time Trial will be available from the Sport Info Office / main building DUKLA – 1st floor from 2:00pm on Sun 30.06.2024. All training bibs have to be given back at the same time.
- The accreditation fee must be fully paid to receive competition bibs.
- A bib deposit of 50 Euro is required on collection of the bibs. It can be paid by cash only.
- CSL Competition / Kayak Cross Time Trial bibs must be returned to the Sport Information Office following the competition for the return of the deposit.
- For the Elimination phases of Kayak Cross the bibs will be distributed at the start area.
- In each bracket Athletes will place over their number bib a colour bib to designate their ranking in the time trial. These bibs will change around depending on who proceeds and will be distributed directly before each bracket by the pre start Judges. Athletes must return the coloured bibs to the dedicated HOC volunteer at the finish take out after their run.
 - Highest ranked = **Red**
 - 2nd ranked = **Green**
 - 3rd ranked = **Blue**
 - 4th ranked = **Yellow**

D. Canoe and Kayak Events

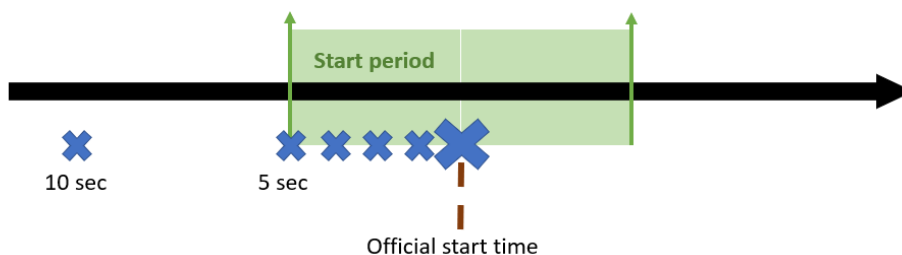
Pre-start procedure

- There will be a clock showing race time and the next athletes to start above the start.

Start



- The starting boat must be alongside the pontoon, facing downstream.
- The beamline is below on the rocks.
- Athletes may move to the start position once the previous Athlete has broken the beam but must be at the start position 15 seconds before their start.
- At all times, the athletes must follow the Starter's instructions, or they may be disqualified for the run.
- For the Teams event one Athlete must be in the start at the pontoon (and be the first to break the beam). The second and third athlete can choose their own position but must remain behind the pontoon.
- At the start, there will be a countdown clock showing the time to start. There will be an acoustic signal (10 seconds before start, and then from 5 seconds before start - 4 shorts, 1 long - start).
- Athletes may start 5 seconds on either side of their official start time which is signified by the long beep on the start clock.



Finish



- The finish beam is just above the rocks before the last roll.
- All Athletes must exit on the left to pass through equipment control and the media area.
- Athletes must not leave the finish zone until dismissed by the Equipment Control Official once they are no longer needed for the ceremonies, anti-doping or equipment control.

E. Kayak Cross events

Start & Finish line

- An automatic start machine will be used for all phases.
- The start time for Time Trials is triggered by activation of start ramp and finish times are triggered by photocell.
- During the Elimination phase a photo finish system will be deployed

Pre-start procedure

- Athletes need to be at the pre-start area prior to their start to prepare their boats (and equipment control during the Elimination phase), and receive any final instructions (coloured bibs distribution, choosing their start lane).
- Athletes need to have completed equipment control, bib collection and be lined up ready to go at least 1 bracket before theirs or risk missing their start.

Start procedure

- At all times the athletes should follow the starter's instructions.
- The start position is with both hands on the paddle and along the side of the kayak. The paddle must be parallel to the plane of the platform. The front hand has to be placed on or over the middle line of the boat on one side and touching the boat or the spray deck.



- The start orders will be the following ones:
 - 1) "In position" => the athletes must place their paddle in the start position
 - 2) "Ready" => the athletes wait in steady position; no movement is allowed following the "Ready" command
 - 3) The platform will tilt to indicate the start. The starter will not say "Go".

Time trials

- Athletes must start from lane 3 on the platform for the Time Trials (third lane from river right)
- The start interval is 40 seconds, athletes should get in their boat behind the platform. They will then be assisted to move to the starting lane.

Elimination phases

- Athletes should be settled in the start position on the ramp 90 seconds before their start time. There will be volunteers to assist them if needed.
- They should then listen to the sports presentation where they will be introduced to spectators.

Finish



- The Finish line will be located in front of the tribunes 25 m after the junction of the two channels.
- Please return the borrowed boats, spray decks and bibs to the start.
- Volunteers will be there to help your Athlete if needed on the ramp.
- At the start a Pre Start Official will inform your Athlete if they have progressed.

Rules reminder

Remember all Kayak Cross rules apply during the competition and official training periods.

- Helmets must be on the ICF list:

- All buoyancy must be above the waist, meet EN norms see:
https://www.canoeicf.com/sites/default/files/2022_extreme_kayak_buoyancy_rules_v1.pdf
- The paddles
 - Blades must be 5mm thick for the whole edge of the blade
 - A gauge will be used to measure the paddle blade radius.
 - The whole length of the blade edge must fill or not enter in the gauge
 - Any paddle not complying will not be allowed.
 - There can be no sharp edges on the blade
- During Qualification (Time Trials) and Elimination phases, the athletes must wear long sleeves
- If an athlete or their equipment falls from the platform before the "ready" => DNS. They must exit from the start platform or the course.
- Any movement between "Ready" and the tilt of the Start machine => FLT at the start
- Whole head and both shoulders must cross the gate line in the correct direction.
- Kayak Roll - at some point, the Athlete needs to be 'upside down' under the barrier. The boat is considered 'upside down' when the Athlete's head is completely under the water. Be aware this means a 'kick flip' roll would not be acceptable.

- Moving gates in an unfair way to disadvantage other athletes => RAL
- Athletes are permitted to "reach across" but not hold back other athletes
- An athlete with a broken paddle must drop back and paddle down the course alone. If they do not, the broken end of the paddle is considered dangerous = RAL. They may drop the broken paddle and use their hands to finish the course.
- Using a photo finish to break tie in elimination phase – this is measured on the bow of the boat.

For Vote at this meeting

Interval during time trials

Existing rules:

10.2.1 - In individual events, starts are separated by at least forty-five seconds.

The proposal is to use a 40 sec interval.

Kayak Cross Training

- Additional Kayak Cross training sessions have been scheduled during the slalom competition, see the updated schedule on Team Info on the website.
- Please note that there is only limited time for these sessions which may be crowded, please respect other athletes.
- When the ramp is in the operation, athletes must not paddle under the ramp. They either start on the ramp or put in below the ramp.
- Athletes must exit before the bridge where the channels merge, they must not enter the slalom course.
- If an athlete paddles under the ramp or enters the slalom course all athletes from their federation will no longer be able to train in the Kayak Cross sessions.

F. Technical Video Service for CSL events

To access the TVS feed each team must attend a "testing" meeting in the Athlete tent at 15:30 on Monday 1st July. Teams who do not attend this meeting will not have access to the TVS feed.

The purpose of this meeting is to make sure that the system will work under full load and to troubleshoot any issues teams have. Mark ABBOTT will be available at this time to assist the teams. Please register to this meeting by filling this form: <https://forms.gle/3QioZVQFa1agpVBe9>

- A TVS feed will be available for all events and demonstration runs.
- Only the download solution will be available. Each Nation tent will be equipped with their own download cable.
- Please enable the option "Automatic (DHCP)" – Mark ABBOTT can assist with this
- Address to use to download videos: <http://cis.siwi>
- Be aware the first access to <http://cis.siwi> may take a bit longer, sometimes 1-2min.

- It is important the WLAN is not activated (off) not only "not connected" to a WLAN-network
- All devices must be connected at the testing time, 9:30 Thursday, so we know the system works under the full load.
- Wireless routers may be used if they are **NOT** within the following frequency
 - 5785 GHz, band width +/- 20 MHz
 - 5825 GHz, band width +/- 20 MHz.
- Any wireless device in these frequencies may affect the delivery of the competition
- At no time should any wireless router system be connected to the computer which is connected to the TVS lan cable
- All devices, including any wireless routers, must be named with National Federation code and device number eg AUS1, AUS2, AUS3 – unnamed devices will be removed from the system
- Any team found to be using a device affecting the competition will have power removed to their compete system

16. Key areas during competition

See the venue map attached in Appendix 1

A. Enquiry / Protest desk

- The Enquiry desk is located in front of the OVR.

B. Equipment control

- Equipment Control is located on the left side of the course next to the parking lot.
- Self-checking is open: Monday 1st July from 7.30 to 15.00.
- Equipment control will be open each day 1h before the 1st boat starts.
- In Canoe and Kayak event, there will be post competition control and random checking
- In Kayak Cross, there will be:
 - o Post competition checking for Qualification phase
 - o Pre-competition checking for Eliminations phase

C. Medal ceremonies

- Location: see map in Appendix 1.
- Schedule: see competition schedule, after each session of final.
- Athletes involved in the Finals for both Canoe Slalom and Kayak Cross should bring their national uniform to the medal ceremony preparation area. There will be boxes there to place the uniform in. There is only a short time between the end of the competition and the medal ceremonies.

D. Doping control station

- The doping control station is in the main building, past the accreditation, down the stairs on the right.
- Athletes will be notified for Doping Control in the finish area.
- Passports or ID are required for Athletes selected for doping control.

E. General information

- **Extra tents** are not allowed inside the venue. **Car parking** for Teams is located at the top of the venue, the parking pass is required, you will get it by accreditation process. The space is limited. Other cars can park opposite after the road.
- It is forbidden to camp in the NF area.
- It is forbidden to walk on the conveyor belt.

17. Special information for the National Federation

A. Opening ceremony

Scheduled on Sunday 30.06.2024 at 18.30 in the main square in city centre. The meeting point for teams is going to be at **18:10** in the parking places – Moyzesova street (Vitalit sport on google maps) and Vajanskeho street (opposite the swimming hall, use the underpass to the main square). See **Appendix 4**. Each team needs to appoint a flag bearer; the rest of the team will follow them to the ceremony.

Opening Ceremony will be followed by **Reception hosted by Mayor**. One person from each national federation will be invited. It will be held in Múzeum Janka Kráľa (arcade building next to the opening ceremony on the left side).

B. Reception

Scheduled on Friday 5th July at 19.30 at the venue, first floor of the building (banquet invitation by accreditation / one per team).

C. Sustainability

Slovakia has recently introduced schemes to increase the recycling. Please separate your rubbish into the correct bins, all PET bottles are deposit. The PET bottles put in the rubbish with the sign of RETURN PET, don't throw it away or damage.



D. Accreditation to the Venue

- The Accreditation office is open every day from 8:15 until 30 minutes after the end of the competition to collect accreditation.
- The Competition office is open every day from 8:00 until 30 minutes after the end of the competition.
- Accreditation will be required from Thursday 10th August when access control starts.

E. Security

- There is security during the night.
- The Organising Committee recommends not leaving anything valuable in the tents, the cars or at the competition venue.
- The Organising Committee will not accept liability in case of theft or disappearance of equipment from the site.

F. Fair Play Award

The Club Fair Play of the Slovak Olympic & Sports Committee in cooperation with the Slovak Canoeing and its Canoe Slalom section has the pleasure of announcing the Fair Play Award to a team or an athlete, coach, spectator, supporter, during the 2024 ICF JUNIOR AND U23 CANOE SLALOM WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS, which will be held in L.
