Age group definition

- The first year an athlete can compete in an ICF international competitions is the year of their 15th birthday.
- The last year an athlete can compete in the junior age group is the year of their 18th birthday.
- An athlete can compete in a masters 40+ in the year that they reach the lower limit of the age group.
- All athletes qualified as Junior, Master, or Para can choose to compete in Senior.



COMPETITION FORMAT

Single race of distance around 2,000m for each gender and age group. Each race will run for 15 minutes (cut off time). The whole competition will be live streamed via @planetcanoe website and our Youtube channel with professional graphics, results, and commentary.

All participants are required to live stream their race via smart device/webcam to be featured on the live stream and to ensure fair competition monitoring. Separate document for set up instructions will be sent out to all registered participants.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

The competition is open to anyone that has access to KayakPro kayak machines with Gensis Port Bluetooth Smart Console. We welcome paddlers of all levels to compete. Contact your local clubs/national federations for access to KayakPro machines. If you have access to the machine but not the Gensis Port Bluetooth Smart Console, you may qualify to receive one as donation from the ICF.

- Internet connection

- 1. Create your account on the Kinomap website, download Kinomap on your smartphone or tablet from Google Play or App Store
- 2. Connect your KayakPro to the application
- 3. Follow the ICF account on Kinomap HERE
- 4. Register for your race <u>HERE</u>
- 5. You will receive an email after step 4 of your registration with details of your race (on a later date)
- * Please note that you have a 14 day free trial period when you register on Kinomap. This 14 days start when you start your first session, not when you register!
